



Acceptable Forms of Identification

All applicants are required to show identification at the time of fingerprint capture at an IdentoGO® by IDEMIA location. Each document will be scanned and verified with the use of a document authenticator with the Universal Enrollment Platform (UEP).

The following is an updated list of all forms of identification for the Maine State program that are accepted at all IdentoGO® enrollment centers as of January 6, 2023. These documents will be accepted for identification purposes ONLY without the need for additional supporting documentation and must include an identifiable photo, the applicant's full name and date of birth. All Documents must be Verifiable and Unexpired.

- Driver's License issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- Driver's License PERMIT issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- Driver's License PAPER/TEMPORARY issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- Enhanced Driver's License (EDL)
- Commercial Driver's License issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- Commercial Driver's License PERMIT issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- ID card issued by a Federal, State, or local government agency or by a Territory of the U.S.
- Enhanced Tribal Identification Card (for federally recognized U.S. tribes)
- Department of Defense Common Access Card
- Uniformed Services Identification Card (Form DD-1172-2)
- U.S. Military Identification Card
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Military Dependent's Identification Card
- U.S. Passport
- Foreign Passport
- Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- Employment Authorization Card/Document (I-766) that contains a photograph
- Canadian Driver's License
- Foreign Driver's License (Mexico and Canada Only)
- U.S. Visa issued by the U.S. Department of Consular Affairs for travel to or within, or residence within, the U.S.

If an applicant's ID document has a different name, the following Name Linking Documents can be presented along with the Primary Document:

- Original or certified copy of a court-ordered name change document, including Marriage certificate or Divorce decree

For applicants under the age of 18 who do not have one of the documents listed above and are being fingerprinted for participating State agencies, a waiver can be presented at the enrollment center. This waiver will not be available at the enrollment center, and must be printed prior to the appointment.

One of the following documents must be presented with the waiver:

- Birth Certificate bearing an official seal (or certified copy) issued by the State, county, municipal authority (or outlying possession of the U.S.)
- Social Security Card
